Code of Conduct for Everyone

- NO** alcoholic beverages, tobacco in any form, radios, rock music, CD players, ipods, MP3 players, TVs, guns, knives, magazines, books, fire works, weapons of any kind, video games or playing cards.
- NO** physical contact allowed between male and female campers.
- NO** medications kept by the campers. All medication will be turned in to the camp directors upon departure.
- NO** sweatshirts, T-shirts or hats with inappropriate advertising.

Code of Dress for Ladies

- ** Modest skirts, dresses, and culottes **ONLY**. These need to be down to the knee and **NOT** tight fitting. Bring one-piece bathing suits for swimming.
- NO** pants, gauchos, or shorts.
- NO** sleeveless tops or dresses, cropped tops, or sundresses.

Code of Dress for Gentlemen

- ** Long pants are to be worn at all times. Belts must be worn to chapel services, with shirts tucked in. Bring modest swimsuits for swimming.
- NO** ball caps to be worn in buildings during services or meals.
No caps are to be worn in a worldly fashion.
- NO** sleeveless shirts, tank tops, sagging pants
- NO** earrings, bracelets, necklaces, etc.
- NO** sweatpants except for basketball. **NO SHORTS!**
